CCYC is a high-energy weekend conference for High and Middle School students in WS during the weekend of February 17th - 19th. This is a great conference to bring friends to!


The cost is \$100, which includes the cost of the conference and 2 nights at the Embassy Suites downtown. Students will also need money for 2 meals.

JESUS AND THE BROKEN WORLD

Breakthrough

Genesis

2 Peter 1:20-21

²⁰ Above all, you must understand that no prophesy of Scripture came about by their prophet's own interpretation of things. ²¹ For prophesy never had its origin in the human will, but prophets, though human, spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

John 5:45-47

⁴⁵ "But do not think I will accuse you before the Father. Your accuser is Moses, on whom your hopes are set. ⁴⁶ If you believed Moses, you would believe me, for he wrote about me. ⁴⁷ But since you do not believe what he wrote, how are you going to believe what I say?"

Genesis 1:1-3

¹ In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ² Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. ³ And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.

Jesus is present, even in the creation of the universe.

John 1:1-5, 9

¹ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was with God in the beginning. ³ Through Him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.

⁴ In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind.

⁵ The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

⁹ The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world.

Colossians 1:15-17

¹⁵ The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. ¹⁶ For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. ¹⁷ He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

³¹ God saw all that he had made, and it was very good. And there was evening, and there was morning - the sixth day.

What did God know and when did He know it?

Genesis 3:1-5

¹ The serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the Lord God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?" ² The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden, ³ But God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.'" ⁴ "You will not certainly die," the serpent said to the woman. ⁵ "For God knows that when you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

⁵ When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom,

Satan cast doubt upon the nature and goodness of God.

**Eve falls for the lie, that God isn't good, and
that God doesn't have your best interest in mind.**

Genesis 3:5b, 7

⁵ ...she took some and ate it.

⁷ Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made coverings for themselves.

The immediate consequence of sin is shame.

Next comes fear.

Genesis 3:8

⁸ The man and his wife heard the sound of the Lord God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

¹⁵ I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers. he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.”
