




## BREAK DAY BRUNCH

### Week 3 - Unseen & Small

<sup>16</sup> ...Simon (to whom he gave the name Peter), <sup>17</sup> James son of Zebedee and his brother John (to them he gave the name Boanerges, which means “sons of thunder”), <sup>18</sup> Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James son of Alphaeus, Thaddaeus, Simon the Zealot <sup>19</sup> and Judas Iscariot, who betrayed him. - Mark 3:16b-19

<sup>26</sup> He also said, “This is what the kingdom of God is like.
