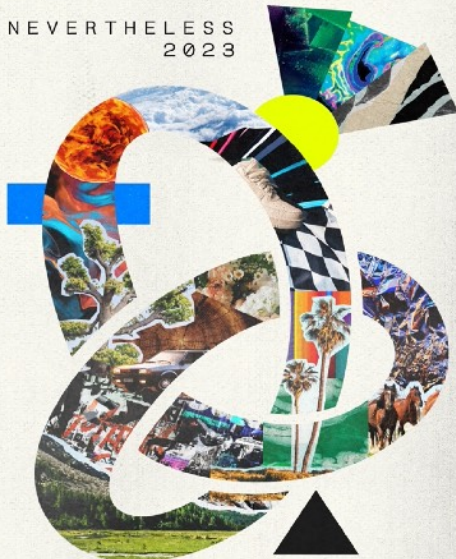

Graduates will be honored in the 11am service. Please make sure they bring their cap and gowns. We look forward to celebrating the class of 2023 and their accomplishments!



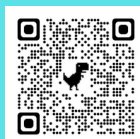

Week 1 The Apostles Teaching

“A river is always purest at its source.”

Acts 2:42

⁴² They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

The Apostles Teaching

2 Timothy 3:16-17

¹⁶ All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, ¹⁷ so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

2 Major Threats To Following The Word Of God:

Legalism

Legalism implies that the Bible is not adequate.

Liberalism

Liberalism tries to weigh the scripture against what is culturally acceptable or personally preferable.

How can we devote ourselves to God's truth?

Read it.

Psalm 119:1-2

¹ Blessed are those whose ways are blameless, who walk according to the law of the Lord. ² Blessed are those who keep his statutes and seek him with all their heart.

Romans 10:17 (NASB)

¹⁷ So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

Memorize it.

Psalm 119:11

¹¹ I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

Obey it.

Trust it.

Psalm 119:138

¹³⁸ The statutes you have laid down are righteous; they are fully trustworthy.

Isaiah 55:11

¹¹ ...my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it
